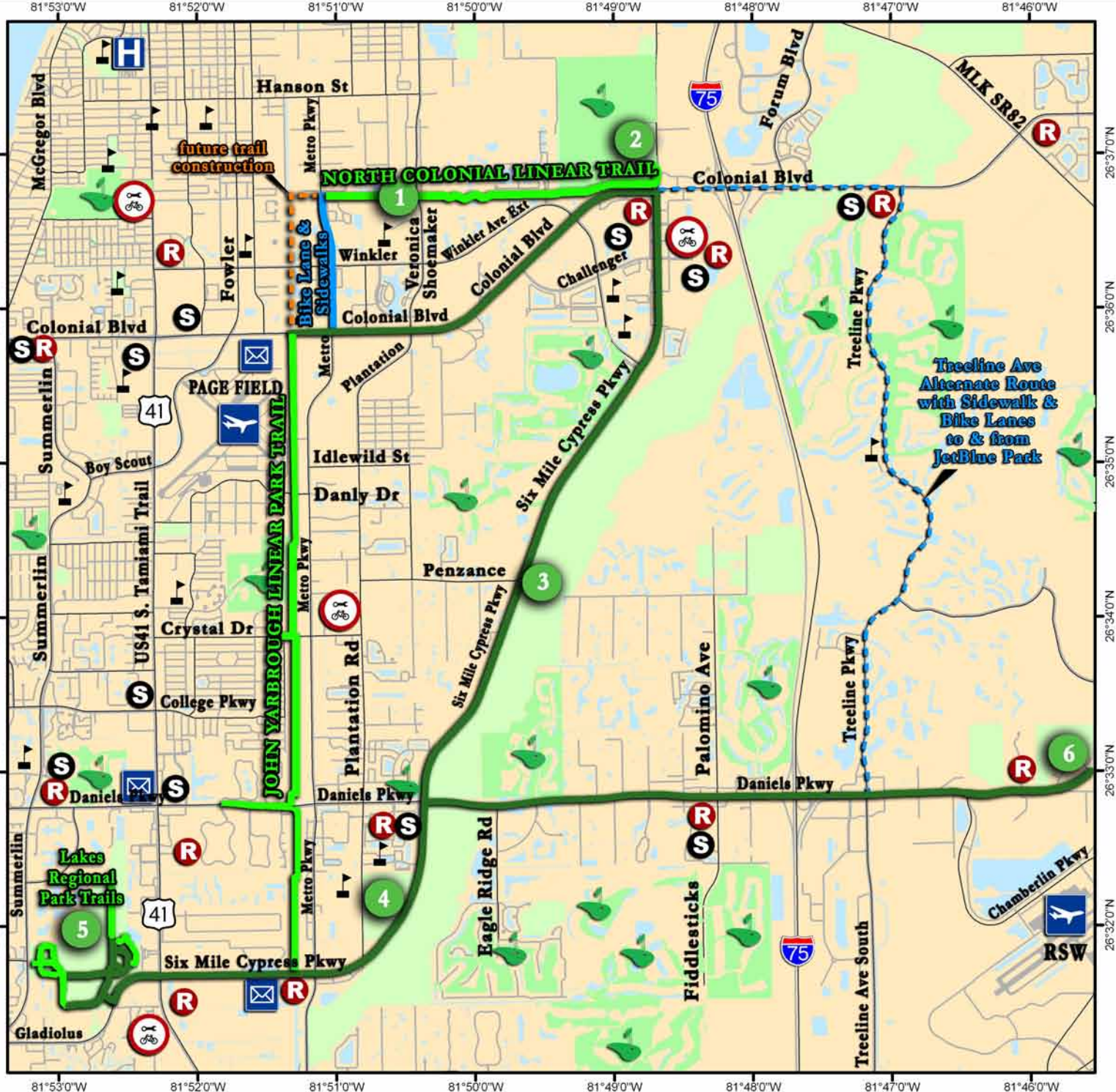









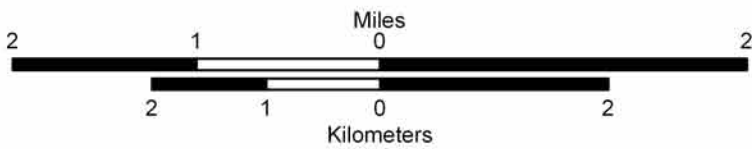


Tour de Parks route - bike - walk - recreate

-John Yarbrough Linear Park Trail

The John Yarbrough Linear Park Trail is open sunrise to sunset. The six mile paved multi-use trail, allows walking, hiking, jogging, rollerblading, bicycling, on-leash dog-walking, fishing, birding, wildlife viewing, and picnicking. -North Colonial Linear Park Trail

The North Colonial Linear Park Trail is open sunrise to sunset. The three mile paved multi-use trail, allows walking, hiking, jogging, rollerblading, bicycling, on-leash dog-walking, fishing, birding, and wildlife viewing. 2 -Calusa Nature Center & Planetarium

3450 Ortiz Ave, Fort Myers, FL. The Calusa Nature Center and Planetarium is a private, not for profit, environmental education organization. Our 105 acre site has a museum, three nature trails, a Planetarium, butterfly and bird aviaries, a gift shop, meeting and picnic areas. Admission Fee. www.calusanature.org

3 -Six Mile Cypress Slough Interpretive Center

7791 Penzance Blvd, Fort Myers, FL. Parking Fee. Park open Dusk to Dawn. No Pets. Center Tuesday-Sunday 10am-4pm. There are three free parking spaces outside the park gate along Six Mile Cypress Pkwy. The interpretive center opened in 2008 and is the first public certified green building in Lee County, Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design (LEED).
